Instructions for Collection of 24 Hour Urine for VMA, Catecholamines, Metanephrines, 5HIAA

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLECTION OF 24 HOUR URINE FOR VMA, CATECHOLAMINES, METANEPHRINES, 5HIAA

- **1.** For proper evaluation of test on a 24 hour sample of urine, it is important that a complete and accurate collection is made.
- **2.** When collecting a 24 hour specimen for these tests, the following foods must be avoided for 3 days prior to the beginning of the specimen collection:

Nuts

Caffeine

Chocolate

Bananas

Alcohol

Vanilla

- **3.** Drink at least two quarts of liquid during the collection period.
- **4.** Empty your bladder when you get up in the morning. Write in the following information:

- **5.** Discard this urine.
- **6.** From this time on, collect in a clean bottle all urine you pass during the next 24 hour period.
- **7.** Make your final collection when you empty your bladder the next morning at approximately the same hour. Write in the following information:

- **8.** Keep the collected urine refrigerated and bring it to the lab as soon as possible after the collection is complete.
- **9.** Labeling—Be sure to pre-label 24 hour urine containers with Patient's Last Name, First Name, and DOB before they take them home to begin collection.
