

Fast answers with the ClinicalKey Mobile App

Leverage insights for better patient outcomes anytime, anywhere with the ClinicalKey mobile app – available for both Apple® and Android™ devices.

- ▶ Open the App Store on your mobile device
- ▶ Search for “ClinicalKey” and install at no charge
- ▶ Once in the app, two options will appear – Click on ClinicalKey
- ▶ Enter your ClinicalKey username and password used for remote access and start using the ClinicalKey App!

Create an account in 4 easy steps!

1. Go to www.ClinicalKey.com and click Register in the top right corner.
2. Using the email address associated with your institution, fill in the required information on the registration page.
3. Click Register when finished. ClinicalKey will display an activation message and sends a confirmation email.
4. In the confirmation email, click the link to officially start your remote access*.

*This will grant 180 days of remote access. Prior to the end of the 180 days, log into your ClinicalKey personal account while on your institution's IP. This will extend access another 180 days. Should your remote access expire, follow the above steps to re-activate your access.

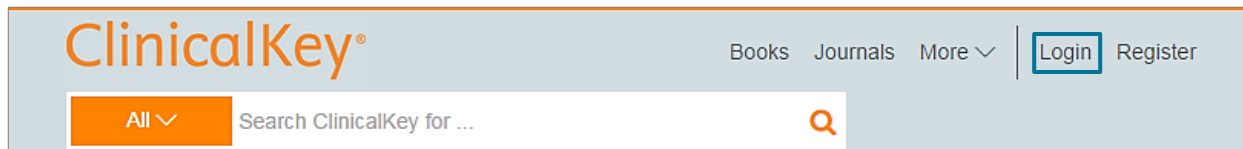

Registering for ClinicalKey Remote Access


Remote access allows you to easily access ClinicalKey when you're not on your institution's network. The instructions below outline how to activate remote access.

For Institutional Users with a User Profile/Personal Account

1. To activate remote access, click **Login** at the top of ClinicalKey.



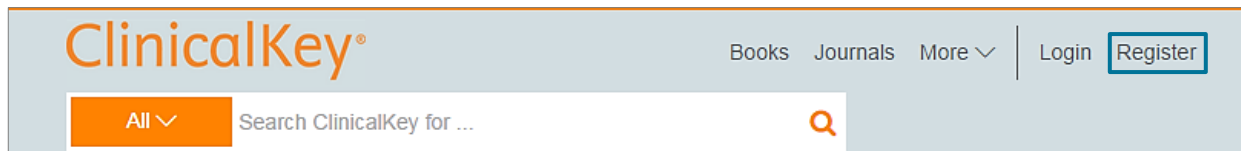
2. From the Login page, click the link under **Remote Access Activation**.
