Camp Prov is for children who are receiving early intervention or special services and their siblings 2 years through 13 years of age (some exemptions may apply). Here, kids can be kids regardless of their challenges.

Activities during Camp:

At Camp, we do all kinds of activities and customize the experiences depending on what your child needs! We have a splash park, Arts and Crafts. Sensory play. Music and Singing, Nature activities, Dance & Movement, and anything else that is fun!

When is Camp?

The kids come for one week, Monday through Friday for either the morning or afternoon sessions. The dates of Camp in 2025 are:

Staff:

Our staff consists of Unit Leaders and volunteers who are trained in working with children of different abilities. In addition, we have an RN or health care professional present. You may also see an OT, PT or Speech Pathologist out there as well! Even so, this is Camp, not therapy!

Fees:

The price for Camp is \$130 per child for the week. We are able to offer Camp at a small fraction of the actual cost to provide this service because of the generous support of the Providence General Children's Association and Providence General Foundation!

If your child has DDA respite hours, you may be able to use them for Camp! Financial assistance is available for those who can show a financial need.
