Patients Served

Amputee rehabilitation services are provided by St. Luke's specialized team of physicians, rehabilitation nurses, case management, prosthetists, wound care nurses, dieticians, and therapy staff including physical, occupational, psychology, recreational, speech and other therapists. St. Luke's provided Amputee rehabilitation services to **98 patients** in 2023 and our patients received an average of **3 hours** of therapy per day. Our Amputee Specialty program utilizes a comprehensive, multi-disciplinary team that works together to provide the best care possible, by using the newest research and latest technologies to maximize the individual goals and successes of each person.

- 58.9 years old is average patient age
- 84.7% discharged to the community
- **12.6** days is average length of stay
- 96.7% of patients were living in the community 90 days after discharge




89% progress at St. Luke's met patient expectations
